Dress Code

All students 5th graders and up who attend IQRA Academy of Cary Masjid should follow the Islamic dress code.

For Girls:

- Hijab (covering the head and the neck)
- Jilbab (not necessarily black), abaya, dresses, or skirts (all must be loose and ankle length unless they are worn over loose fitting pants).
- Pants must be full length and loose fitting.
- Shirts must be loose, long sleeve and must cover the hips at least.

For Boys:

- Pants must be full length, relatively loose fitting.
- Shirts should be loose and covering the hips (not tucked into the pants).

Please notice that students will be asked to contact their parents for a change of clothing if they are not dressed appropriately.
